Dear Middletown Township Residents:

[The below information is supplemental to the 02.18.2020 posted notice]

Sunoco made a request for continuous pullback of the 20" pipeline at HDD610 (Route 1/PSP Barracks) on February 17, 2020; written request posted to Township website on February 18, 2020. The Township has granted limited 24/7 construction permission to ETP/Michels that will expire at 9:00 p.m. on Monday, February 24, 2020 with conditions that include:

1. Work may not start before Saturday, February 22, 2020 at 7:00 a.m. in order to comply with Township Code, Chapter 155, Section D.
2. Notice must be provided to all of the residents who will be affected by the work such that they have clear advance notice of the activities that will be taking place outside of the normal work hour restrictions. Residents should be provided with the necessary information for them to understand what is taking place and why the round-the-clock effort is necessary. This may include property management employees when applicable.
3. Enhanced sound barriers must be provided in order to mitigate noise from generators and other equipment. This should be done in consultation with the Township engineer.
4. Lighting must be arranged to minimize the effect on the residents.
5. Movement of vehicles should be reduced to the absolute minimum during the overnight hours.
6. Workers should proceed with their activities quietly and with the utmost respect for the residents. Proper decorum must be maintained at all times.
