Dear Middletown Township Residents:

Staff was advised by Sunoco representatives that the continuous pullback of the 20" pipeline at HDD610 was completed late Saturday evening, February 22, 2020. This segment of the pipeline is located at Route 1/PSP Barracks, from Granite Farms Estates south under Route 1/Baltimore Pike.

Also reported to the Township by Sunoco staff, the purging of the 12" GRE line, specifically the venting of the pipeline, has taken longer than anticipated. No Sunday construction occurred to lower a segment of the pipe, and daytime only work will occur this week to complete the lowering of the purged 12" pipeline. Normal construction hours in the Township are 7:00am – 9:00pm, Monday – Saturday.

[Update 02.24.2020, 12:14 p.m.] The 12" GRE line maintenance work is compliant with the Township ordinance working within a right-of-way with an HVL, as this work is outside the ¼ mile distance from Glenwood Elementary School.
