Dear Middletown Township Residents:

Staff was advised by Sunoco representatives that the integrity work to lower the 12" pipeline near the PSP Barracks will require overnight staffing at the Glen Riddle valve station. No overnight construction will occur. As reported by Sunoco, once the lowering and maintenance of the purged pipe is completed, preventing moisture from entering the line is important for integrity purposes. Managing the moisture levels of the pipe will be completed by staff at the Glen Riddle valve station, south of Tunbridge Apartments, by venting nitrogen under lower pressure.

The overnight venting activities is not expected to create the higher audible whistling noise that occurred during the Saturday, February 22, 2020 venting effort. Immediate surrounding residential properties are being contacted by Sunoco representatives on the noted activities, which will include limited site lighting.

If there are concerns, Sunoco has established a contact number for residents to call: 855-430-4491.

Tomorrow (Wednesday, February 26, 2020) will have potential flare activity during daytime hours when product is reintroduced to the pipeline. It is not anticipated at this time that refilling activities will extend beyond 9:00pm on Wednesday, according to Sunoco, and the Township will make another post if activities would extend beyond the normal operating hours.

The maintenance work on the 12" pipeline is to provide greater protection by lowering the line and maintaining the pipeline integrity is of strong interest to the Township for public safety.
