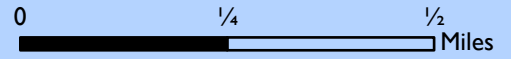

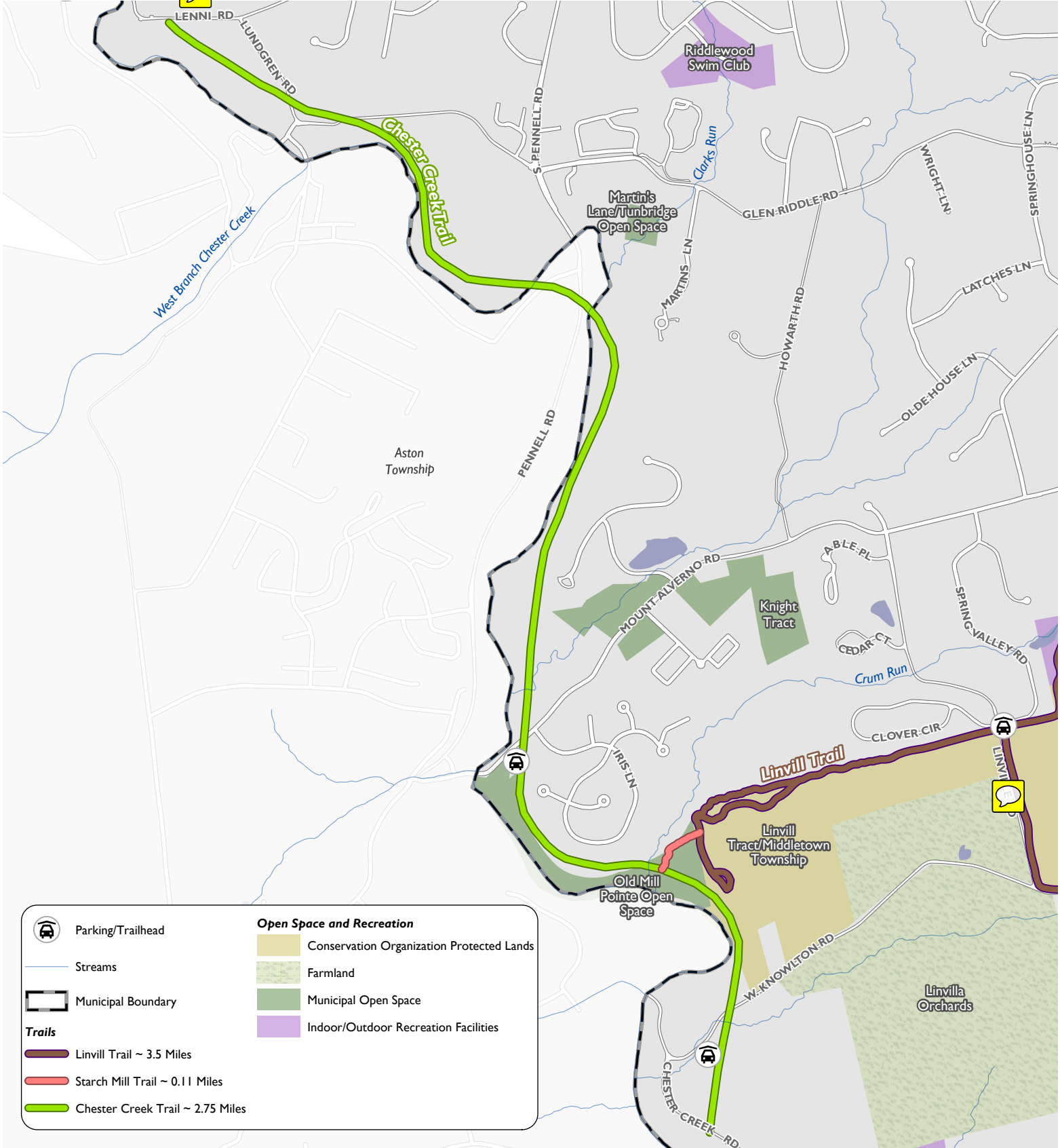












# Chester Creek Trail



Chester Creek Trail is a paved, multi-use trail approximately 2.75 miles in length that is managed and maintained by the County of Delaware. The trail, which opened in April 2017, is a relatively flat, 10-foot wide paved trail that is great for walking, running, and bicycling. Parking is available at Knowlton Road and Mount Alverno Road. The trail follows along Chester Creek through the corridor of the old Chester Creek Branch rail line between Lenni Road and Creek Road. Several bridges carry trail users over the water, creating special views both upstream and downstream. The trail continues through serene wooded settings with unique rock outcroppings and incredible fall foliage. It can also be accessed via the  trail.
