RE: SCHEDULE OF WORK UPDATES FROM ETP/Sunoco February 7, 2022

See the below schedule of work that will take place at South Pennell Valve site this week:

Energy Transfer/Sunoco is preparing to commission the final segment of the 20-inch Mariner East 2 (ME2) pipeline between Wallace Township, Chester County, and Middletown Township, Delaware County. The line fill will begin on February 9th. During these activities, neighbors may observe flaring at the South Pennell Valve site. Any noticeable activity is being managed by trained and qualified personnel under controlled conditions. It is important to note that this is not construction work. ETP/Sunoco will work to minimize any inconvenience that this work may cause and will limit any light or noise disturbances. While ETP/Sunoco always does their best to make sure any work maintenance or service work of their utilities conform to work hour guidelines, it is not always feasible to do so. In the event crews need extended time to complete this work, ETP/Sunoco will reach out directly to the Township.

Breakdown of work:

- 2/8 – Mobilize equipment to valve site
- 2/9 – Propane flaring at valve site.
- 2/10 – Increased site activity during fill. Potential flaring.
- 2/11 – Increased site activity.
