**RE: Lane Restriction on W. Forge Rd and Valley Rd**

This afternoon ETP/Sunoco notified the Township of a lane closure approval from PennDot on W. Forge near the Valley Road intersection. The lane restriction is due to Michels mobilizing a drilling machine to complete borings to gather core samples. This action resulted from the Township's ongoing monitoring of this intersection to ensure the public safety of the residents. Prior to restarting drilling at Sleighton Park, the Township required ETP/Sunoco to implement a below ground monitoring plan at this intersection. The monitoring plan demonstrated a difference in results collected last week. Due to tonight's storm, Sunoco had to suspend the boring and will resume work in the morning. In the meantime, flaggers will be on site overnight to assist with traffic control related to the lane restriction. The results of the samples collected will determine the reopening of the lane. An update will be provided as soon as information is obtained.
