We are sending this letter as a courtesy to share information about pipeline work in your area.

As you are aware, we are nearing completion of both the 16- and 20-inch Mariner East pipelines in Delaware County. We are pleased to be finishing final tie-ins and preparation work before safely placing the pipelines into operation.

In the coming weeks, you will notice increased activity as we complete the 16-inch pipeline tie-in at Glen Riddle Station, located near Martins Lane. This work will require excavation and potential flaring. You will see heavy equipment and increased truck traffic on site, and you may see visible flames due to flaring. Please note that this is routine maintenance and preparation work. We have made contact with County 911 and local officials to advise that any noticeable activity is being managed by trained and qualified personnel under controlled conditions.
