

Daytime Tree Trimming **September Through Mid-October**

Maintenance of Power Transmission Wires to be Performed in Area. Work Needed to Maintain Access to Transmission Wires and Towers

Beginning on Wednesday, September 7 and continuing over the next five to six weeks, Asplundh will be in the area trimming tree branches and brush along the SEPTA power transmission wires and towers adjacent to your property. Work will be performed six days per week (Monday – Saturday) between the hours of 8:00 AM – 5:00 PM.

Work is anticipated to be working in the following neighborhoods in September and early October when crews will be clearing the ground brush and trimming back any branches that may be in contact with or pose a risk to the wires. Please see map – dates are estimates:

- Chester and Brookhaven: September 7 – September 16
- Park Lane in Aston: September 11 – September 22
- Kingston Terrace (Aston) to Greenbriar Place: September 18 – October 13

Affected residents are being notified directly and Asplundh personnel will follow-up with any property owners in advance of cutting work. Work will include the use of chainsaws, a wood chipper, and bucket truck. Chipped materials will be removed from the project.

About the Project:

A power transmission wire runs from the City of Chester to the Lenni Road substation in Middletown, passing through several municipalities. Every decade or so SEPTA performs maintenance along the line to clear the line of branches and dead trees and to maintain access to the towers in the event a power repair is needed.
