**RE: SCHEDULE OF WORK UPDATES FROM SUNOCO/ETP STARTING SEPTEMBER 19, 2020**

- 1) ETP currently has the 20-inch hydrotest scheduled for **Tuesday, September 22<sup>nd</sup>**. As mentioned earlier today, there will be noise associated with the de-pressurization and dewatering of the pipeline following the completion of the test. This noise will either occur later in the day Tuesday or Wednesday morning. As this work gets closer we will have a better idea of which day there will be noise coming from the site. Expect there to be activity at Sleighton Park all next week as we complete the test and then demobilize the equipment.
- 2) HDD 631 pullback continues to be moved up, we are into some soft rock. Crews will be finishing the ream today or tomorrow and then swab the hole in preparation for pullback. Crews are currently targeting the beginning of pullback on **Tuesday, September 22<sup>nd</sup>**. Again, like all construction this date may slip.
- 3) Just received word that ETP has PECO scheduled to raise their lines this **Saturday, 9/19 at 9am**. We have spoken with all three landowners that would be impacted (14 / 16 & 18 War Trophy Lane) all have confirmed that they are good with this work taking place at this time. PECO has also confirmed that the outage should only be between 10 and 20 minutes long. PECO planned their work to create the least possible impact to these three residents. ETP also spoke with the Township Engineer a little while ago and confirmed with him that all of this work is taking place north of Riddlewood Drive within our existing LOD.
