**RE: SCHEDULE OF WORK UPDATES FROM SUNOCO/ETP October 9, 2020**

Friday, October 9, 2020

Sunoco/ETP contracted crews are prepping HDD 620 (Riddlewood/Sunnybrae) in anticipation of hydrotesting the pipeline on Saturday, October 10, 2020. There may be construction - vehicle/equipment noise associated with the preparation work.

Saturday, October 10, 2020

**7 – 8am:** Crews will begin 8 hour hydrotest segment of the pipeline between 143 Valley Road and HDD 620 (Riddle/Sunnybrae Community).

**2 – 4pm:** Crews will complete the hydrotest and relieve pressure from the pipeline. A majority of this will take place at 143 Valley Road. There is a chance that Sunoco will need to relieve some pressure at Riddlewood, but it will be for a short duration and minimal compared to recent noise caused by exhausting at HDD 591 (Sleighton Park).

**Activity at Riddlewood:** There will be general construction activities taking place at Riddlewood and air compressors will be running. Michels (contractor) is well aware of the yard sale there tomorrow and will have more safety personnel on site during these work activities.

**Notifications:** Delaware County Emergency Services “911” Center was notified today to expect 911 calls regarding the work.

Tuesday, October 13, 2020

Michels (Crews) will run cleaning equipment (pigs) through the pipeline to dry and clean it. There is some noise associated with this activity, but it is for a very short duration. Again, Sunoco/Michels will do their best to make sure all noise is limited to 143 Valley Road (Sunoco House).

\* No work/activity is scheduled for Sunday or Monday, October 12<sup>th</sup>, 2020 because of the federal holiday.
